
Hospice and Palliative Care Services During Times of COVID-19



We are prepared, as always, to care for hospice and home health patients, at home, in facilities, and at McClure Miller Respite House. We recognize that the population we care for is uniquely vulnerable to severe illness with COVID-19. These patients will benefit from our team's support for decision-making and symptom management. Our goal is to maximize care in the home setting, both to provide the best care possible and to minimize the demand on hospital-based resources.

SERVICES

- Home health and hospice RNs have proper Personal Protective Equipment to provide medically necessary care in the home.
- We are resourced to provide remote visiting from our interdisciplinary team to our clients and family members.
- We offer social work outreach to homebound patients who are at high risk of severe illness due to COVID 19. The goal is to provide education, explore values and offer decision-making support.
- We have a palliative care provider through UVM Medical Center on call 24/7 should urgent questions arise around supporting and palliating COVID-19 patients in the home or facility setting.
- The McClure Miller Respite House anticipates providing inpatient hospice care to COVID-19 positive patients.
